## Reflecting on the Word:



We are all workers in God's vineyard. There are many people who are a part of God's plan and who proclaim his Word among us—from the prophets, the disciples, the evangelists, the pope, our parish priests, catechists, and even

members of our family. How might we be more receptive to God and his messengers? How are we called to be proclaimers and listeners to his Word?

The vineyard's grapevines produce grapes, a fruit that many enjoy eating. As workers in God's vineyard, what type of "fruit" are we called to produce? # Transformation of Mind

Saint Paul encourages us to resist anxiety and fear. How does he suppose we achieve this goal? He proposes a certain method. He tells us to pray and petition God about everything. I think so many times we forget about God and try to handle everything ourselves. Many times, during our life we do not act like God is in control or has the power to assist us. He also says to remember thanksgiving. Gratitude has a way to adjust our perspective and attitude and reframe our experience according to God's principles and promises. When we are intentional about this practice then the peace of God will guard our minds and hearts. The word choice is very interesting and insightful in this passage. It does not say we will defend our hearts and minds but that the peace of God, the Holy Spirit, will guard us through the person of Jesus Christ. After this Saint Paul instructs us concerning what things we reflect should reflect on. Think of what is true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, and gracious. Does that description sound like most of our contemporary culture? It is something to discern and think about for ourselves.
