## **Mandatory retirement withdrawals**



Starting this year, the age at which required minimum distributions must be taken from tax-deferred accounts like IRAs and 401(k)s moves from 72 to 73. If you are thinking of giving to charity please

consider *St. Gabriel Parish*. You can set up a qualified charitable distribution and give up to \$100,000 per year directly to St Gabriel from your IRA. The donation counts toward your RMD without increasing your taxable income.
