Family Talk Time: <u>Celebrating Sunday for Catholic Families:</u>

Ask your children, "Why do people have such different gifts? What do you think God wants you to do with your gifts?" What happens if we do not use our gifts? What happens when we do use our gifts? To whom do these talents belong?

Reflecting on the Word:

We are often the first ones who notice new talents showing up in



our children's lives. As parents, it is our job to point these out and to help our children put them to use. As they attempt to use their God-given gifts, our children may be afraid to try new things. We can encourage them to take new risks by entrusting them with greater levels of responsibility as they

grow, demonstrating our faith in their abilities and by offering support throughout the process. Finally, we all long to hear "well done, my good and faithful servant." Be sure to offer regular words of affirmation as you encourage your children to use their gifts.

Living the Word:

Write a list of talents or gifts seen in each family member. Read the list aloud, affirming each person, offering examples of how they demonstrate that gift in daily life. Invite each family member to consider which gift, skill, or talent they most enjoy and how that gift may be used to build the kingdom of God.

Father Marc's Minutes...

Use God's Investment Wisely

The gospel parable speaks of a master investing and entrusting his servants. The master distributes resources to each servant based on their ability. When the master returns after some time has passed, he settles accounts with the servants. The servants who received 5 and 2 talents came forward and presented the return on the master's investment. The master praises them and entrusts them with further responsibility. They did well with the little steps that resulted in a large return. However, the one who had 1 talent allowed fear to overwhelm him and he panicked. He buried the talent in the ground and tried to hide. The master was not pleased and severely punished that servant. I can empathize with that last servant. At times life, responsibilities, and commitments can be overwhelming. My temptation in those times was to curl up and hide. It is the same reaction that the servant had too. However, the Lord is inviting us to make progress step by step. The other servants were successful because they made little changes day by day to achieve larger results. You may not be able to change a habit immediately, but what important actions can you take now? The Lord is indeed with you. Remember what Saint Paul says in the second reading, "but you, brothers, and sisters, are not in darkness, for that day to overtake you like a thief. For all of you are children of the light and children of the day."


