

# Reflecting on the Word:



As parents, we are concerned with the details of daily life (who will roll back the stone for us), and we often find what we are worried and concerned about had already been taken care of (the stone was already moved). This Easter, may we, like

the women at the tomb, encounter the surprise, the amazement, the joy of God's plan being fulfilled in the resurrection of his Son. Even in our worry, doubt, or confusion, let us be restored and find our hope in the risen Christ.

# **Living the Word:**

Jesus rose from the dead two thousand years ago. Think about all the people in your life whose lives have been transformed by the risen Christ. Make a timeline and list all the people in your family, going back as many generations as possible. Widen your list to include people in your neighborhood, or people in your church (including the saints) who were transformed by Jesus' resurrection. God has a plan for all of creation to enjoy fullness of life with him. Leave some space on the front of your timeline to write about how you are working with God to bring about his plan.

# Happy Easter

I want to wish everyone a very blessed and happy Easter! Jesus is risen and has defeated the power of death for all time. During Holy Week we celebrated the Paschal Mystery which is the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus. Holy Thursday recounted the Last Supper of the Passover Jesus shared with the Apostles. In the Last Supper Jesus instituted and left two sacraments for the church to sustain and nurture us. Jesus gave us the Eucharist and the holv priesthood to provide for our spiritual well-being. Throughout Holy Week Jesus has revealed himself in so many new ways. Jesus is the new king leader like the new Solomon, he is the new Joseph that was sold by his friends, he is the new temple of God, he is the new priest and the sacrificial victim, and Christ is the new Adam who undoes the curse brought about by original sin. Are you ready for Spring? The cemetery crew is! We ask that you please remove gravesite items between April 1-15. Anything that is not removed after these dates will be removed by


staff and discarded. Please help by removing these items and save us some work! Thanks!
