Family Talk Time: <u>Celebrating Sunday for Catholic Families:</u>

What do you think of when you hear the word peace? What does it mean when we greet one another with the words "May the peace of Christ be with you?" What are we wishing for the other person? Why do you think Jesus' first words to his disciples after the resurrection was peace?

Reflecting on the Word:

When there are disagreements among family



members, we are encouraged to "make peace" and shake hands or embrace the other.

Sometimes we are not ready to embrace one another in an act

of peace. How are we able to practice sharing peace with one another? In today's Gospel, Jesus stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." How do we allow Jesus to enter those moments of forgiveness and peace in our home? Is it easier to make peace when we are aware of his presence?

Living the Word:

As a family, look for instances of peace, harmony, or contentment in your week. Have your children write about those instances or draw a picture of those moments, and then share those moments with the family.

Divine Mercy Sunday

The second Sunday of Easter is known as Divine Mercy Sunday. This feast comes from the conversations of Jesus with Saint Faustina. During prayer the Lord would talk to her and communicate special graces to her. She was a mystic and God showed her deep and mysterious things. Jesus made the request for special devotion to Divine Mercy to be spread around the world. Her prayer and the revelations God showed her are recorded in her diary. I would highly encourage everyone to read and pray for this with rich spiritual resources. Jesus promises particular graces to overflow from heaven on this day. This feast day is a beautiful testimony to God's desire to bestow mercy. In the diary Jesus says that now is the time for mercy where God demonstrates his patience. At the end is the time for judgment and justice. I highly encourage everyone to accept and hold onto this promise of Divine Mercy. Please pray for your loved ones in a particular way on this day. I invite everyone to join me in saying the *Divine Mercy* chaplet this Sunday after Mass at 11:15am in church. The chaplet is a beautiful and powerful prayer invoking God's mercy for the world by the merits of Jesus Christ's passion.


