What do you think it would have been like for the disciples to see Jesus risen? Why do you think they were afraid at first? Jesus told the disciples that they were to be witnesses to the Good News. Is it only the disciples who are witnesses to the Gospel? How are we called to be a witness to the risen Christ?

Reflecting on the Word:



When one of our children has a frightening dream, we want to hold them and soothe them. When we have moments of feat, we too, need to be consoled by the one who can give us the sense that all will be well. It is easy to trust him when all is well with our lives, but when we are "startled and terrified" by life, we also need to turn to him. it is in those moments that we must witness to the world of his faithful love, and how we trust in his comfort and care.

Living the Word:

As you gather for your evening meal, think about how you have witnessed the love of the risen Christ today. Where did you see his love present? Did you happen to get a glimpse of it at home? In your neighborhood? At church? Read about it in a book or online? Or did you see it in nature, maybe in nature, maybe in your own yard or in the park? Let everyone share their own witness story. If you did not see one today, be mindful of looking for glimpses this week.

Light and Darkness

I hope people were able to experience the eclipse earlier this week. I was able to head over to my parents' house and witness this momentous occasion. It was my first time observing something like that. The shadows lengthened, the color temperature of the rays shifted, and there was a short time of less light. The moon looked bigger than the sun for an hour even though we know that is not the case. The eclipse reminded me of the importance of perspective. Sometimes the things that are less monumental appear to be larger than life due to perspective. Struggles can appear larger than life compared to God if they occupy the forefront of our minds and attention. But we know that the sun is larger, more powerful, and more majestic than the moon. Praising God has an inherent power to change our perspective and remind us that problems or struggles are not bigger than God. This is why the scriptures say to praise God always.
