***Items not allowed will be  
tagged and removed this year  
October 15th-31st in the Fall  
Cleanup***

***Thereafter items will be  
tagged and removed on-going  
and in the Spring Cleanup,  
April 1st-15th and the Fall  
Cleanup as well. Once an  
item is tagged it will be  
removed after two (2) weeks.***

### **St. Anthony Cemetery Columbarium Policy and Regulation**

NOTHING is allowed to be placed in the area of the Columbarium. This policy includes placing NOTHING on or in the surrounding ground.

Specific examples of items not allowed:

Ring stands

Baskets

Vases

Potted plants

Artificial flowers

Artificial plants

Planted flowers, trees or shrubs

## **ST. ANTHONY CEMETERY SPACE POLICIES AND REGULATIONS**

1. These are the ONLY items permitted:
  - Ring stands (each holding a pot of 10" maximum diameter) between April 1 and October 14
  - Grave blankets from November 1 to March 1
  - Flags only on Memorial Day, Flag Day, and Veterans Day
  - One (1) statue and one (1) vigil light
2. Examples of items not permitted:
  - Artificial flowers or artificial plants
  - Glass vases, planters, rocks, or lawn ornaments
  - Styrofoam, balloons, toys or anything else the weather will move
  - Flowers planted in ground
  - Edging of any sort
  - Shrubs or trees planted in the ground of the Cemetery space without permission of the Sexton or the Cemetery Committee.
  - Shepherd hooks or any stands other than ring stands
  - Items not allowed will be removed and disposed of
3. Spring Cleanup is April 1-15. Fall Cleanup is October 15-31. Items not allowed will be removed during these dates as well.
4. Pets are allowed in the Cemetery on a short leash. Any pet droppings must be cleaned up by the person accompanying the pet.
5. No skateboarding, roller blading, roller skating, cross-country skiing, snow-shoeing or snowmobiling is allowed in the Cemetery.
6. The Cemetery is not responsible for articles stolen from within the Cemetery.
