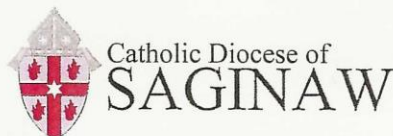
Entertainment and special guest waiters will be on hand to add their special flare to the evening. Silent and live auction items will include gifts and experiences for many tastes and budgets
